

An Easter Invitation to You for 50 Days of Counting

For 2,000 years, followers of Jesus have remembered his dramatic story of resurrection from the dead. What may be surprising to learn is that Easter is the *Beginning* of God's big resurrection story. In the biblical calendar, God's people began counting days in a progression from our Easter toward what is called the day of Pentecost — the conclusion of a 50 day spiritual journey. If we begin counting the days on Easter, we will arrive at Pentecost on Sunday May 31st. Agriculturally, the period of Easter to Pentecost is the crucial spring growing season; a dead winter gives way to radiant bursts of new life. But spring is also a risky time for farming: wind, rain, hail, heat. Crops need a
